At last months meeting I introduced a change to our By-laws that was voted in unanimously by all 12 members present. That change is as follows:

Incumbent president has the option of extending their term additional years, 1 year at a time. With the approval of the general membership present by a majority vote. Notice must be given by October of their final year. Unless apposed by a candidate for the position of president. At which term time will be normal 2 years for the newly elected president. Any officer may be re-elected unlimited amount of times.

With this enactment I now declare my intention to remain Chapter 66's president for one more year. Unless of course someone wishes to run for the presidents position or you don't approve with your vote. I do this in order to see through the projects I have started.

I want to encourage all Chapter 66 members, and especially those who belong to other organizations that use our building, to look out for the welfare of the chapter. This extends to being alert to anyone not paying for beverages, seeing that the building is locked and the A/C and lights are turned off. We have found some problems in these areas. Sometimes resulting in more cost to the chapter. If we can keep these costs down, we won't have to think of ways to get the cost back.

I will be installing a new electronic lock on the chapter building door soon. I will send the code to the appropriate people. All 66 members are entitled to use the building. If you need use of the building, contact me for the code.
