Well the holidays are over and it is back to our normal level of excitement. Our first order of business is our monthly meeting on Tuesday, February 9th. Our guest speaker will be Dr. Wayne Burr, M.D., AME, who will talk to us on the FAA, aviation physicals and Oklahoma City. Dr. Burr is experienced in all aspects of aviation medicine and can answer questions on this subject. So get your questions in order and be prepared to have them answered. Dr. Burr will start his presentation about 8:00 P.M. Feel free to invite guests who may have questions on light sport, physicals and current requirements.

The next event is our Fly-Out to Sundance A/P on Saturday, February 20th. Sundance is a 3000ft. grass field, 010/190, 4nm northwest of LaBelle. To find Sundance fly to LaBelle (X14), and line up with Runway 32. Fly this heading for 4nm and you will be directly over the field. There is a windsock in the middle of the field. Communicate on 122.8 talking to LaBelle/Sundance traffic. This is the present practice used by all Sundance traffic.

The Fly-Out includes a BBQ around noon. Hamburgers, buns, chips and soft drinks will be provided. Adult beverages are optional. Potato salad and coleslaw are needed. Our thanks to **Tom Fausel** for hosting this event. At this point, we have Tom and Ray Romeu with seats available in their planes. If anyone wants a ride, let myself or any officer of EAA 66 know. We will be coordinating plane rides to Sundance.

If you drive to Sundance, take Hwy 80 to the center of LaBelle and turn left on CR78N. As soon as you cross the bridge, turn left onto Crescent Road and follow it to the end. There will be a pond on your right. Turn left onto the gravel road which is Frenwood Lane. Continue on for 3 miles and the airport will be on your left. If you get lost call 239-699-1704.

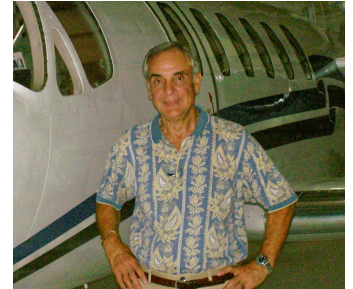

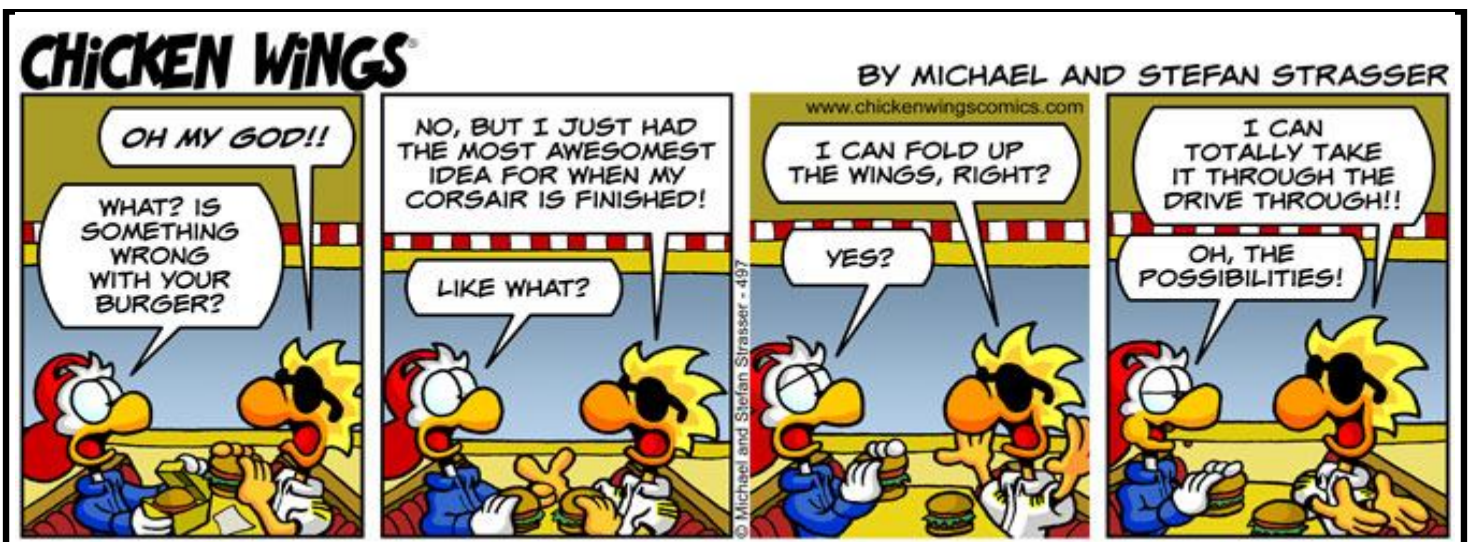
